The CAREPATH project represents a collaborative achievement, integrating technical and clinical expertise to develop an ICT platform that supports clinicians and informal caregivers in managing older patients with multimorbidity and mild cognitive impairment or dementia.

Innovation management is a multifaceted process that often involves cultivating the team's mindset to ensure all ideas generated during the project are thoroughly evaluated and, when appropriate, chosen. In CAREPATH, this process proceeded seamlessly, with consistently excellent collaboration among team members. The various aspects and steps have been presented in the editions of this document:
